LANDLORD PERMISSION LETTER

The Inter-Faith Food Shuttle (EIN #56-1753180) is a hunger relief organization that has been working to end hunger in our service area that includes Chatham, Orange, Durham, Wake, Johnston, Nash and Edgecombe counties for 30+ years. Our mission is to 'pioneer innovative, transformative solutions to eradicate hunger'. One of the innovative ways we address the problem of hunger is to teach people how to grow their own food.

We are kick starting a new program called **Gardens For Everyone** to address problems of hunger and access to fresh food in our community. The COVID-19 pandemic has reinforced the importance of being able to grow your own food at an easily accessible location. **Gardens For Everyone** aims to make your backyard the most accessible location for food access. We would like to build one 4' x 8' raised-bed garden box in your renter's backyard. This garden box is completely removable and non-permanent, and we expect there to be little permanent change to the yard from the installation.



This letter is intended to ask for permission for your tenant to allow us to install the garden box and to allow them to maintain the upkeep of the box as long as they reside there. By signing this letter, you indicate to us that you understand the size of the box, and the non-permanent nature of this project.
